# GREENWICH VILLAGE

## 格林威治的暖人午后

本案是一套位于纽约曼哈顿区格林威治村中心地带的公寓。它建于一栋20世纪60年代的现代派建筑内。公寓主人是一对年届三十的年轻夫妇及他们新出生的宝宝。拥有一个功能齐全、线条干净、舒适的现代风格的生活空间是他们对生活品质的诉求。公寓古老的建筑风格及其历史为室内设计带来了诸多灵感，例如：设计师将多种柔和的色调及各式纹理与定制的家装饰和来自上世纪五六十年代的复古风格的陈设相结合，打造出焕然一新的空间。

其中，各种材质、纹理贯穿其中，构成了整个公寓的一道亮点：门厅内由木头片制成的天花板纸打造出有如破云而出的阳光大放光芒的效果；客厅内的威尼斯灰泥墙有着如同白桦树般的纹理效果；书房内铺设的夏布流露出无限温馨的气息，与室外景色巧妙相融；而经过喷漆处理的餐厅则为空间增添了一丝精致与生气；厨房铺设的软木地板不仅纹理独特，还从侧面反映出业主所从事的酿酒这一职业。

此外，公寓自然光线充足。临街一面茂盛的树木已迎至窗户旁，与室内形成强有力的自然联系。室内空间与大自然之间的联系决定了设计师选用各种中性色与蓝绿色调搭配定义室内各空间，其中蓝绿色的选用从淡绿色、到橄榄绿，从淡蓝色到深蓝绿不等。室内随处可见的工艺品挑战着公寓的空间比例大小，同时也反映出公寓主人正值青春的活力。



The clients are a young couple in their 30's with a new child. A functional, clean-lined, comfortable and stylish apartment is what they really wanted. The building is an interesting modernist structure built in 1963 and situated in the heart of Greenwich Village. The architecture of the building and it's history inspired the interior of the home – muted tones with lots of texture combined with custom upholstery and vintage furnishings from the 50's and 60's.

Texture is apparent throughout the apartment – the foyer ceiling paper made from thin sheets of wood creates a sunburst effect; the venetian plaster walls in the living room resemble the texture of a birch tree; the classic grasscloth in the study creates warmth and connects one to the outdoors; the lacquered dining room adds



sophistication and sparkle; and, finally the cork floors in the kitchen are not only textural, but graphic in design and refer to the family's involvement in the wine industry.

The apartment is flooded with natural light. Trees from street level rise up to the apartment windows and create a strong connection to the interior. This connection with the natural world dictated our palette of neutral tones combined with various blues and greens – from soft celadons to deep olives and pale blues to dark teals. The art work throughout challenges scale and reflects the clients youthful energy! **M**
